#### What is the Governor's Youth Commission?

The Governor's Youth Commission (GYC) is composed of Arizona high school sophomores, juniors and seniors from all fifteen counties. The purpose of the GYC is to mobilize youth to be informed on the greatest challenges facing Arizona and to implement service projects that impact their communities across the state. Commissioners of the GYC learn how to serve on a board, participate in workgroups, plan service projects and events to become leaders in their communities. Each year members on areas of focus such as, substance abuse, education, domestic violence awareness, and distracted driving prevention.

#### **Commissioner Commitment**

**Term:** Commissioners serve a one (1) year term, but may apply to serve up to three (3) terms, so long as they are still in high school and are selected through the renewal application process.

**Travel:** Mileage reimbursement is available for those Commissioners traveling 50 miles or more from outside of Maricopa County. Prior to all reimbursements, the Arizona State University Participant Support Certification and the Arizona State University Substitute W-9 must be filled out, signed, and sent to the GYC Program Administrator.

**Meetings:** The full Commission will have four quarterly meetings throughout the term, including Orientation. Each Commissioner will also be placed into a Workgroup that meets on a bi-weekly basis and conducted via Google Meets.

### **Governor's Youth Commission- Commissioner Responsibilities**

- Ensure Onboarding Online Form is submitted to GOYFF.
- Perform at least five service hours per month (August through April) and solicit at least two peers to join you in conducting service hours.
- Serve as a positive role model and adhere to a high standard of conduct.
- Take initiative in coordinating activities and leading community impact projects.
- Track and report service hours performed and service hours solicited.
- Attend four quarterly Commission meetings a year, must arrive on time and be prepared.
- Actively participate in a Workgroup.
- Adhere to Workgroup deadlines for projects.

- Conduct themselves professionally at all meetings, events, and on all social media.
- Provide for their own transportation to all GYC Meetings and events.
- Encourage and inspire other youth to serve their communities.
- Advance the work of the GYC in full coordination with the GOYFF staff.
- Wear appropriate GYC attire when asked.
- Enjoy networking and collaboration.
- This is a non-partisan, non-political position, but you must be able to represent the Office of the Governor in a positive way at all times.
- Participate in remote Commission Meetings and Workgroup Meetings.
- Respect and follow directives of the GOYFF staff.
