Limited Jurisdiction

- State Grand Jury
 - **Limited Jurisdiction**
 - Powers and Duties → A.R.S. § 21-422
 - Organized Crime, Fraud and Terrorism
 - Title 13, Chapter 23
 - Illegal Control of an Enterprise A.R.S. § 13-2310
 - Money Laundering A.R.S. § 13-2317
 - Prostitution + Occurs in more than one County or affects the residents of another county
 - Sexual Exploitation of Children (Chapter 35.1) + Occurs in more than one County or affects the residents of another county
- We need jurisdictional hook!

- (1) Traffickers
- (2)"Customers/ Johns" Seeking Minors
- (3) Illicit MassageBusiness (IMB)

INDICTMENT

CHARGING VIOLATIONS OF:

COUNT 1: CONSPIRACY, a Class 3 Felony, in violation of A.R.S. § 13-1003

COUNT 2: ILLEGALLY CONDUCTING AN ENTERPRISE, a Class 3 Felony, in violation of A.R.S. § 13-2312

COUNT 3: MONEY LAUNDERING IN THE SECOND DEGREE. a Class 3 Felony. in violation of A.R.S. § 13-2317

COUNT 4: OPERATING A HOUSE OF PROSTITUTION, a Class 5 Felony, in violation of A.R.S. § 13-3208

Prosecuting a Trafficking Criminal Enterprise

- Conspiracy =
 - Individuals +w/intention to promoteoffense + agree + overt act
 - Class 3 Felony
- Illegal Control of an Enterprise
 - Two Types
 - Control over an illegal enterprise – OR –
 - Employed/associated with an illegal enterprise + conducts the illegal enterprises affairs through racketeering - OR-
 - Participates directly or indirectly knowing the enterprise is engaging in racketeering



Prosecuting a Trafficking Criminal Enterprise

- Money Laundering, in the Second Degree
 - Acquires or maintains an interest in, transacts, transfers, transports, receives or conceals the existence or nature of racketeering proceeds knowing or having reason to know that they are proceeds of an offense.

Illicit Massage Business (IMB)

- What is an IMB
 - The appearance of legitimate massage business
 - In reality, offering sexual services in exchange for money
- Fueling commercial sex buying
- Potential for labor trafficking
- Likely involved in a larger, expansive criminal network

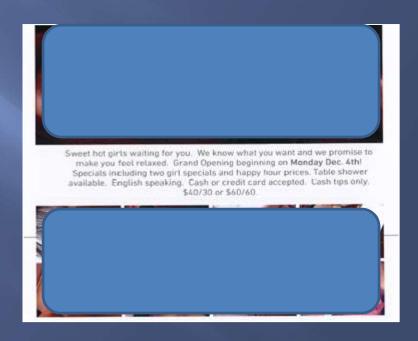
Key Indicators a Business is Selling Commercial Sex

- Prices for massages significantly below market
- Serves primarily or only male clientele
- Locked front door, customers can only enter if buzzed in or through discreet back or side doors
- Windows covered
- Women appear to be living in the establishment



Suspects' Roles

- True Owner/Operator
- STRAW LICENSE HOLDER
 - Usually Male
 - Paid Monthly \$500 Straw Licensing Fee
- STRAW UTILITY ACCOUNT HOLDER
 - Usually Male
 - Paid \$500 Monthly Fee
- Ads
 - "plus more"
- Review Websites
 - Johns post their experiences



Investigation Tactics

- Surveillance
 - Customer Counts (male vs. female)
 - Females turned away
 - Length of stay
 - Observe owners/straw license holders
- ID Males for Stops
- Bank records
- UC Operations

 - Forever Prior

Goals of Prosecution

- Dismantle Network
- Close IMBs
- Asset Forfeiture
- Fines
- Plea Language
 - Defendant shall not direct, oversee, manage, hold a business license for, or have any interest in any massage related business.
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
