To be the best and most trusted community partner for behavioral health, early education and crisis services for children and families in need in Southern Arizona.

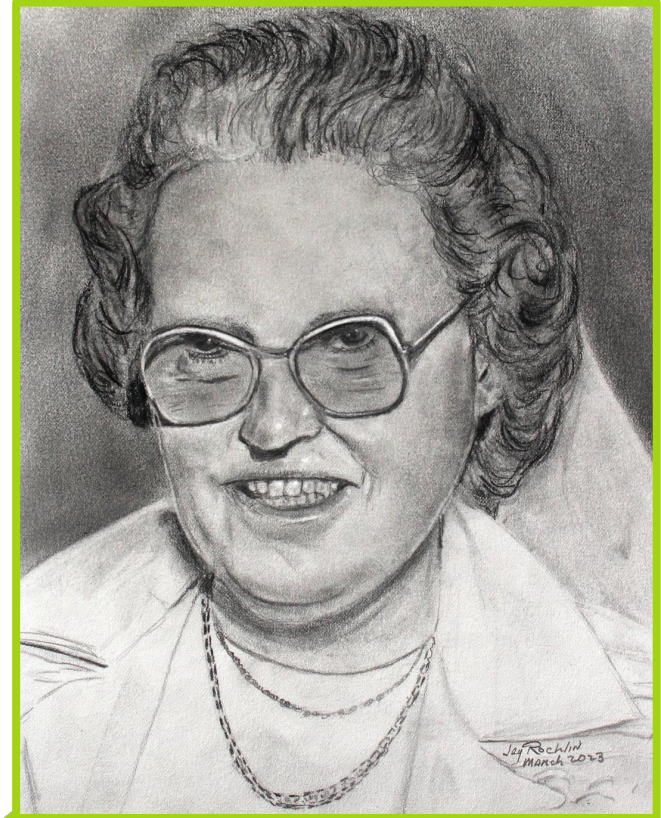
