








WHAT IS IT?

A grant that provides funding statewide to support child abuse prevention programs and family advocacy centers across Arizona.

HOW IS IT HELPING?

Since its establishment in 1999, over \$10 million in grant funding has been awarded to community partners focused on child abuse awareness, education, and prevention efforts.



IN 2024, \$100K IN GRANT FUNDING WAS AWARDED TO FOUR ORGANIZATIONS TO SUPPORT CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION PROGRAMS.

Fiscal Year 2025
