- Three year DOJ grant ended on 03/31/19 after extension granted
  - Victim centered approach
  - Partnership with FBI, HSI, and CODAC
  - Subcommittees
- Unit tasked with new focus to lack of staffing
- Loss of dedicated FBI agent but relationship with HSI continues
- Back to grassroots (reactive vs. proactive)
  - Patrol based incidents, tips, limited operations

#### **MOVING FORWARD:**



- High Risk Juvenile subcommittee meetings continue with even more attendees now
- Focus on community outreach:
  - Social Media Safety & Awareness for Parents/Adults
  - Human Trafficking 101 Awareness on request
  - Table events, radio show
  - Sex Trafficking Awareness to detained girls at PCJCC just started
  - New pilot program (support group) focusing on high risk youth at group homes is pending

# Collaborative effort between CODAC, PCJCC, DCS, and TPD to address high risk youth in group homes

Introducing a new co-ed group for AHCCCS-enrolled teens ages 12-17 who are survivors of human trafficking or youth at risk of being trafficked.

- Empowerment
- What to look for (signs of grooming behaviors)
- What does it mean to be taken care of?
- Gender norms
- Developing beliefs and values

- Healthy relationships
- Safe sex
- Coping skills
- Power & control
- Drug & alcohol use
- Sharing testimonies
