





#### **BRIEF HISTORY**

- DETENTION CENTER (PRIOR TO 2015):
  - \$800K TO \$1 MILLION TO OPERATE
  - Average Daily Population of 1.7 JUVENILES
  - 6-8 WEEKS OF VACANCY
- DETENTION CENTER CLOSED JULY 2015
- JULY 2015 MAY 2017:
  - \$90,000 per year (up to 4 juveniles per day in Navajo County facility)
- GRAHAM, NAVAJO AND GILA COUNTIES CLOSE THEIR DETENTION CENTERS AS WELL

#### **OBJECTIVES AFTER LEARNING TOUR**

- INTAKE AND TEMPORARY HOLDING AREA
- 23 HOUR RESPITE, STABILIZATION, ASSESSMENT (AOC "ALTERNATIVE CENTERS")
- LEGACY TEEN CENTER PROACTIVE ENGAGEMENT WITH TEENS
  - MUSIC, ART, VIDEO/AUDIO EDITING, TUTORING,
  - COMMUNITY COLLEGE ACCESS,
  - COORDINATING WITH LOCAL HIGH SCHOOLS (DANCES, TAIL GATE, CLUBS)
  - APACHE COUNTY YOUTH COUNCIL INCENTIVES FOR SELF-PACED LEARNING


