

Criminal Advertising Trends.

- June 2013 New York Times reported that in 2010 Craigslist made \$44,400,000.00 in one year from prostitution ads. A third of their annual gross revenue.
- California Department of Justice recorded a jump of 5.3 million dollars in 2008 to over 135 million dollars in 2014 for backpage in the "adult services advertising". 90% of their annual revenue.


