# ARIZONA DV RELATED FATALITIES

In Arizona, between 2008 and December 31, 2022 there were 1,552 domestic violence related deaths. Of these tragedies 210 of the victims were under the age of 18 and 74 of the victims, under the age of 24, were killed by a current or former intimate partner. (ACESDV Domestic Violence Fatality Report)
