


Our Service Area

We cover **81,000** square miles of territory


We work with **900+** Agency Partners throughout Arizona.

- Commodity Senior Food Program
- A monthly distribution of shelf-stable commodities, accompanied by a 2 lb. cheese block
- Senior eligibility:
 - 60+ years old
 - Client must meet USDA Income Guidelines
 - Resident of Arizona

- 3rd Party Delivery Vendors: DoorDash, Windjammer, Hello Fresh, Hungry, etc.
 - SMFB partners with 3rd party vendors to delivery directly to senior homes in high need food desserts over our service area
- Senior Living Facilities
 - SMFB partners with more than 60 residential facilities where SMFB deliveries product and service coordinators distribute food along side SMFB staff
- Average monthly households served = 4,800
