#### **Unlocked Environment**



Bridges Eligibility

- Youth with new charges who do not qualify for detainment.
- Youth without charges, referred by law enforcement, behavioral health, or probation for respite purposes.
- Runaway juveniles

- Detention Screening Instrument
- Massachusetts Youth Screening Instrument (MAYSII-2)
- Minor Victims of Sex Trafficking (MVST)
- ACEs Trauma Assessment
- Juvenile and Parent Action Plans



# Probation Resource Officer

- Primarily engaged with schools in the community
- Connects families to community resources
- Provides follow up to families to aid in success
- Identifies high risk juveniles
- Liaison for law enforcement and community outreach






